

Materials for Adeline's workshop: a painting/collage class

**IF PAINTING IN OILS, ACRYLICS, or PASTELS**

BRING WHAT YOU HAVE: brushes, containers (if acrylics or oils) palette, rags or paper towels.

If you don't have any of these supplies, please feel comfortable reaching out to me, and I will suggest.

If you use acrylics or oils, get a body set (yellow, blue, red, green, black, white).

If using pastels: get either OIL or soft pastels. Bring what you have. If you end up needing to buy them, get an inexpensive set.

Bring a couple of surfaces: such as canvas pads, wood surface, thick watercolor paper, a mat, or any other surfaces you can glue and paint on.

I suggest a set if you are getting acrylics. It is less expensive, and you can decide whether you like using acrylics or not.

Bring drawing materials: newsprint, paper, pencil, charcoal and/or pen.

Sketchbook

Get a container for water, bring a palette "Masterson Sta-Wet palette" for acrylics is terrific and you'll need the palette paper for these. You can also bring, to start with, a plate or a palette if you already have one.

Paper towels or rags to clean up.

**IF DOING COLLAGE :**

Acrylics and/or Pastels

\*you will need a couple of surfaces (canvas pads, wood surface, thick watercolor paper, a mat, or any other surfaces you can glue and paint on or draw on.

Get magazines, and cut both flat and printed pages, many sizes, and whole pages.

Newspapers, printed papers, pretty paper.

Scissors.

Drawing materials: sketchbook, pencil, charcoal, pen.

Get a medium gel from Golden SOFT GEL or REGULAR GEL you'll use quite a bit of this as it will be your glue.

Bring paper towels or rags to clean up.
